DEMOGRAPHIC & PROPERTY RELATED PROFILE



- Total QTN population is 3,013 people, with a population density of 2,766 people per square kilometre (from a total land area of 1.33 square kilometres).
- Population average age is 42.2 years. Of note, 67.4% of QTN's population is within 15-64 years of age.

 Private households by tenure: 71.3% owner, 28.7% renter. The average value of QTN dwellings was \$379,378 (2015).

LANGUAGE, CULTURE & DIVERSITY PROFILE



- Mother tongue for QTN is 72.4% English, 7.6% French. Languages spoken by at least 10 individuals within the neighbourhood include Arabic, Vietnamese, Philipino, Slavic languages, Germanic, Italic, and Chinese.
- 60.7% of the population is at least third-generation Canadian, 17.8% is second generation Canadian, while 21.7% is first generation (2015).
- 22.8% of QTN earns at least \$70,000/year, with 8.7% of the population earning over \$100,000/year (2015).
- Median total QTN household income for private households by household size is \$84,970 (2015), while the median total income of two-or-moreperson households is \$99,818 (2015).
- QTN unemployment rate is 5.7% (2015), lower than Ottawa's rate of 6.4%, and lower than Ontario's (6.9%) and Canada's (7%) for the same time period.
- 36.8% of QTN has a university certificate, diploma or degree at bachelor level or above, with 22.1% a Bachelor's degree, and 10.8% a Master's degree
